Ordinance O-2015-05

**AN ORDINANCE AFFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF BRIAN K. DEEL
AS A FULL-TIME PUBLIC WORKS TECHNICIAN AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on June 24, 2014, the Amelia Village Council enacted Ordinance No. O-2014-29, appointing Brian K. Deel to the position of probationary public works technician; and

WHEREAS, the Council of Amelia Village acknowledges the successful completion of the probationary period required by Ordinance No. O-2014-29 and affirms the Mayor's recommendation to appoint Brian K. Deel as a full-time public works technician.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of Amelia Village, Ohio, that:

SECTION I. Council hereby concurs with the recommendation by the Mayor and affirms the appointment of Brian K. Deel as a full-time public works technician for Amelia Village.

SECTION II. Brian K. Deel is hereby employed as a full-time public works technician for Amelia Village at a starting salary of \$16.00 per hour, effective January 12, 2015.

SECTION III. All prior Resolutions or Ordinances or any part thereof, which are inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent part(s) thereof and the remainder of said Resolutions or Ordinances not inconsistent with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION IV. Council hereby finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees, if any, which resulted in formal action, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with applicable legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION V. This ordinance is hereby declared an emergency which is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, and general welfare. The reason for such necessity is that the immediate need to provide the necessary public works services to the citizens of the Village. Therefore, provided this emergency clause receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of all members elected to Council, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

MR. DICKERSON moved to suspend the rules requiring three readings on three separate dates.

MS. KRAFKA seconded the motion.
