There will be no summer picnic held this year, due to scheduling conflicts and low attendance in past years.

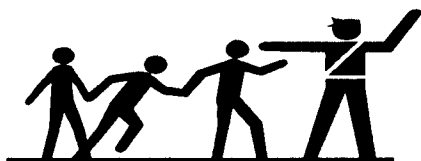

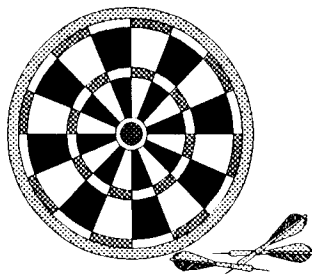
## Rumor Patrol ... What's Up

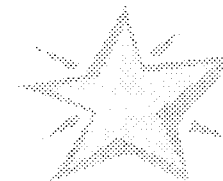
