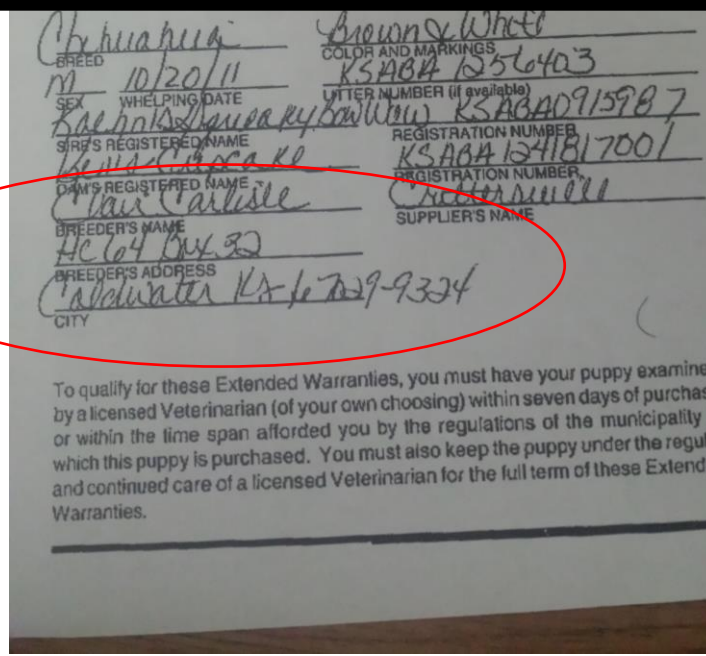
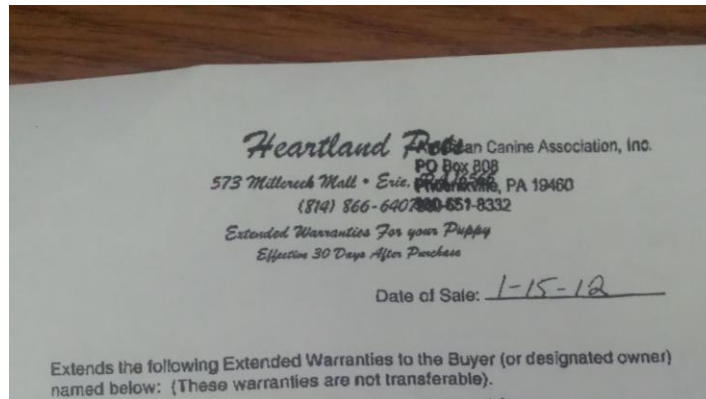

This puppy miller had 69 adult dogs, and 24 puppies on property at the 2015 inspection (the most recent inspection when this record was turned in to us) Violations are listed below. According to the Animal Welfare Act & the USDA Standards – a dog never needs to be let out of a wire kennel that is only 6 inches longer than its body, NOT including the tail. This miller may not have many violations, but her operations are still cruel. Tell Heartland you won't stand for them supporting these cruel businesses any more.

**LOST TAGS.**

Approximately 21 adult dogs do not have official identification because their tags have been lost and not replaced. Official identification is necessary to track dogs throughout the kennel. Whenever tags are lost the licensees must make an attempt in locating them and reapplying them to the dogs. If lost tags are not located the licensees must affix another tag to the dog. Correct by 9 April 2015.

**2.75** (a) (1)

**RECORDS: DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS.**

There are no records for approximately 6 litters of puppies that were present at the time of the inspection. Proper record-keeping is essential to be able to track and record the movement of animals. For all litters, the licensees must fully and correctly record information such as date of birth, official identification number, sex, breed, and color or markings and the date of disposition. Correct by 9 April 2015.

**3.1** (a)

**HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.**

The following areas are in need of repair:  
The wooden support for the shade material in one enclosure is broken allowing the shade material to sag.  
The welded wire fence lining the wire panels in one enclosure is bunched up exposing the dogs to openings in the welded wire fencing.  
Pieces of carpet are being used for door flaps on two enclosures. These have been shredded and now strands of carpet are hanging into the doorway.  
These areas could cause injury to the dogs housed in these enclosures. All housing facilities for the dogs must be designed and constructed so they are structurally sound and must be kept in good repair to protect the dogs from injury. Correct by 26 April 2015.

**3.6** (a) (2) (i)

**PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.**

Some sheets of metal that had been buried along the fence line of several dog enclosures have now become uncovered. This has resulted in metal edges being in contact with the dogs. Also one sheet of
