The ley-lines facing north from Chapultepec Park configure the out-stretched 'eagle' eclipsed by a Horned Owl Molech-Bat. The Eagle is Mexico's national emblem of an Eagle grasping a Serpent as a snake is also configured at the base of the Eagle-Owl/Bat. The Masonic emblem of the owl, when the layout is placed up-side-down acts as the fulcrum for an 8-candlestick Menorah. The Owl/Bat hunts at night and sleeps with its eyes open. An owl is associated with 'wisdom' of the ancient secret societies. The Bat is symbolic of demonic evil forces of the night and it is used as a euphemism for vampirism as the occult require blood-letting from their sacrificial victims. This is much like the Aztecs did with their captors atop their pyramids. The Owl/Bat has its wings out-stretching in the Luciferian iconoclastic fashion of pointing 1 wing up and the other wing down, 'As Above, So Below'.
