Focus on Health Care & Education

- Meaningful interaction between travelers and a healthcare professional in Greece will allow a chance to discuss the internal medical system. Better understand the challenges Greece faces with health care delivery and access to care with ever-growing incidence of chronic disease, as well as the impact of pandemics.
- Learn more about Hippocrates's legacy as you explore sites
 dedicated to the Father of Medicine. He spent his last years in
 ancient Larissa, and you will see the small monument (statue) and
 tomb as well as nearby Diachronic Museum. Also explore
 Hippocrates botanic garden and cultural center in Kos.

Focus on Community & Culture

- Take part in a fun **hands-on introductory cooking lesson** to learn traditional Greek dishes like *gyros* or sweet rag pie called *patsavouropita*.
- Visit iconic sites like the Panathenaic Stadium where the first modern Olympic games were held in 1896. In route to the Acropolis of Athens your guide will point out many sites including the Temple of Olympian Zeus and Hadrian's Arch.
- Enjoy a truffle hunting adventure with truffle hunting dogs and their handlers in Meteora. Chefs will use those truffles along with local mushrooms to create some tasty dishes for you to enjoy.
- Visit the hilltop monasteries of **Meteora** and explore the gorgeous Aegean islands of **Kos** and **Nisyros**.
