Pat Ortiz in the service fighting Fidel Castro with his .22 rifle and not having any luck at it.

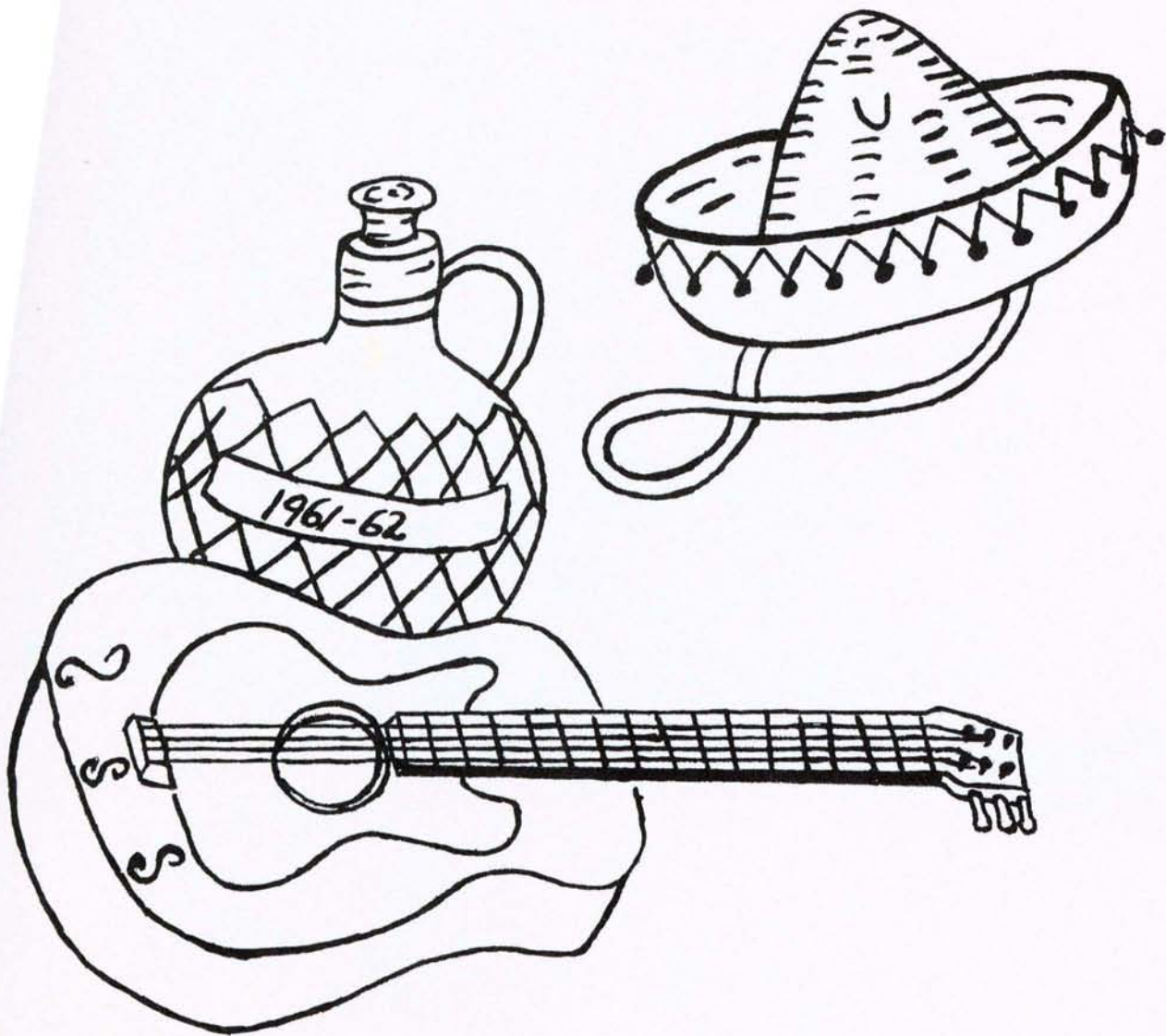
Frank Tafoya running a nice, solid business with pick and shovel to support a dozen children.
