

The shipping industry continues to be a struggle as we try to get containers to countries that have been hit hard with the aftermath of the COVID pandemic. We get cries for help as rising prices makes it impossible for the people to purchase food and clothing.

We are excited to say that one of the projects that isn't affected by the issues with the shipping industry is the Ghana Rice Project. With the support of so many generous donors, we were able to send money to a local mill in Ghana. They distributed rice to 18 missions there since the beginning of the year. We also sent money to newly ordained Salvatorian priest, Fr. Simon Muema, in Kenya, so he could purchase rice for his and surrounding communities.

As we grapple with the day to day difficulties, I think, why can't this be easier? We are trying to do good for so many people in need around the world. It is then that I think about an article in the church bulletin that attracted my attention

We look forward to seeing all of you!






