## 2nd Public Meeting 7<sup>th</sup> Street Corridor Urban Redevelopment Plan

## WHAT?

The City of Cordele invites you to attend a 2nd public meeting to continue reviewing and providing comments on the **Draft 2025 7th Street Corridor Urban Redevelopment Plan.** The Plan describes the proposed vision, primary land uses, development patterns, and community work programs of three distinct 7th Street Corridor character areas: Medical Center, Downtown, and South Corridor.

## WHY?

The 7<sup>th</sup> Street Corridor Plan is bounded by 5th Street to the east and 8th Street to the west between 1st and 27th Avenues. The purpose of the Plan is to eliminate and prevent the development or spread of slum and blight, to encourage needed urban rehabilitation, and to provide for redevelopment of slum areas.

The Plan proposes to redevelop slum areas through the enforcement of housing, zoning, occupancy controls and standards, and the rehabilitation of slum areas.
