

James Arthur "Jim" Krause, age 83 of Sand Point, passed away Sunday, April 30, 2017 at Scheurer Hospital in Pigeon.

He was born in Capac on March 15, 1934, and was the son of Richard and Hilda (Schuneman) Krause. Jim was a 1952 Capac High School graduate and attended Central Michigan University.
