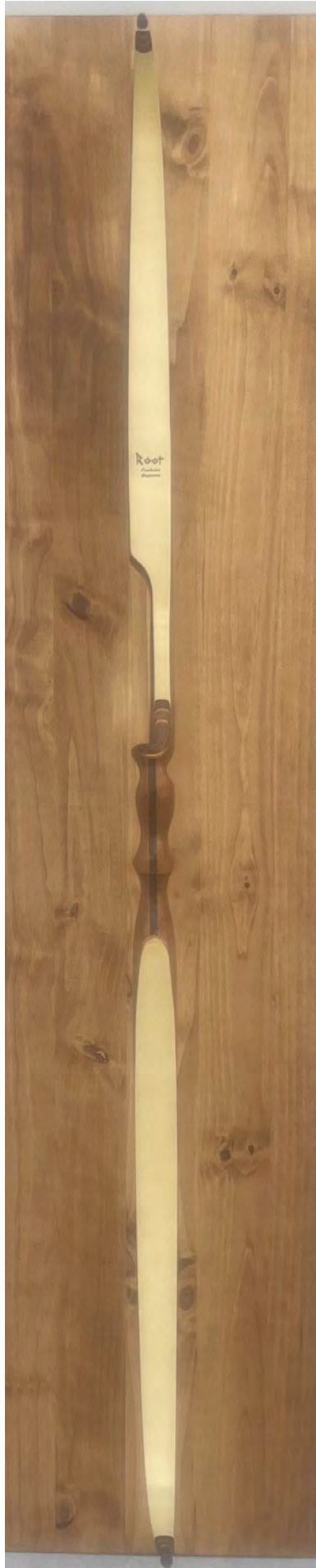

DESCRIPTION: The Pendulus Supreme was Ernie Root's top-of-the-line bow, and is considered one of the highest performing target recurves of all time. This bow is in excellent condition and has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. 2 professionally filled screw holes on the back of the riser which are invisible except at very close range. Close up you can see that this section of the limb has been restained. Typical yellowing of the limbs. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in very good shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow was put to a stress test (held at full draw for 16 hours to make sure the old glues still held and no stress cracks developed. Comes with a new string.

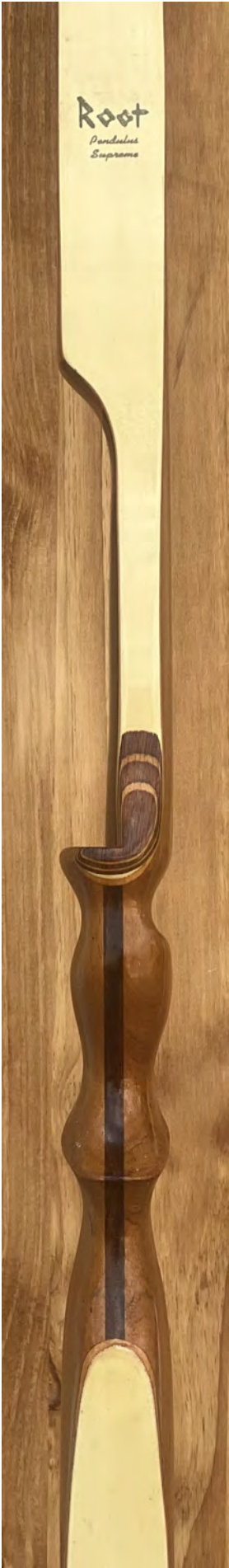
This bow sold for \$150 in the mid 60's, which translates to \$1,492 in 2024 inflation adjusted dollars.
