BEDFORD – North Lawrence Community Schools’ alternative program, Gateway Academy, has taken up residence at StoneGate Arts & Education Center, 931 15th St. for the duration of the 2019-2020 school year.

Gateway Director Kelly Storms oversees the program, the young people and their classroom day, with the assistance of full-time certified teacher Maleaha Evans and one support staff person, Charlie Titcher. In addition, Storms has plans to add a 20-hour literacy tutor, to be funded jointly by Bedford Public Library and Hoosier Uplands.

StoneGate is a modern environment and calm atmosphere, Storms said. It is not over-stimulating for the young people and features nearby access to downtown businesses and community resources, allowing students numerous opportunities to engage and give back to the community.

Students are referred to Gateway by their building principals. The program comprises young people who have been removed from their enrolled school for a specific time because of behavior issues, academic non-compliance or because they require high school credit recovery, have chronic absenteeism, or an identified issue preventing success at school.

A support team, including NLCS administration, counseling, teachers, parents and the child, come together to make the determination, Storms said.
