WHERE CAN I FIND UPDATED INFORMATION?

- Parish Website, Online Bulletin/Letters, Parish App, Facebook, and Social Media.

- No paper bulletin or any paper/mailling communication will be available at this time.

WHEN CAN I COME TO THE CHURCH OR PARISH OFFICE?

- The Church will be open during designated times for Adoration and Confession.
- The Parish Office will be open Monday - Friday 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM
- All appointments for Father Vinner, Deacon Jim, and Joan Mikulski must be made through Nathan Scott, Parish Administrative Assistant for in-person meetings and spiritual needs.

WILL THE CHURCH BE CLEAN?

- The Church will be deep cleaned twice a week. Light cleaning and sanitization every day.
- All paper, prayer cards, rosaries, missals, booklets, magazines, song books, etc., will be removed.
- Hand sanitizer will be available at designated areas of the Church during public hours.
- We ask all those who come to the Church during these times to please wash their hands.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION, MINISTRIES, SACRAMENT PREPARATION/CELEBRATIONS?

- ABSOLUTELY ALL events, programming, ministries, councils, committees, and non-essential gatherings are cancelled as far as physical meetings in church spaces. (i.e. bible studies, Knights of Columbus meetings, rehearsals, volunteer meetings...)
- Religious education and ministries are encouraged to engage parishioners by creative means whether online or emailed resources.
- Sacrament Celebrations are postponed until further notice. Confirmation Date remains scheduled.

FUNERALS, ANOINTINGS, BAPTISMS, WEDDINGS? (All will proceed)

- Limitation to 10 people or less, and immediate family only (Staff people ARE included for the count)
- Contact Joan Mikulski or the Parish office to make an appointment.
- Anointing of the Sick - Father will be available for the Sacrament to the homebound with proper clearance from a nursing home or care facility. A strict protocol will be followed for those who are requesting the anointing as a house visit at the discretion and evaluation of Father Vinner.

STEWARDSHIP

- All other stewardship by mail, monetary gifts, pledges will still be accepted and dropped off at the Parish Office.

WHAT IF I KNOW SOMEONE WHO OR AM AFFECTED BY THE COVID-19?

- If you are experiencing symptoms of the Corona Virus, please contact your local Public Health Department and make a report. Also contact Parish Office Staff, who will then report to the Archdiocese of Seattle.
