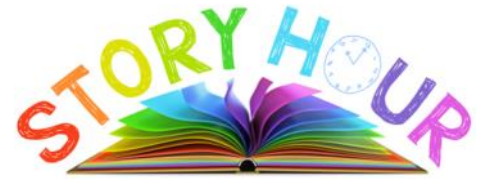
Ukulele Lessons (for ages 14+)

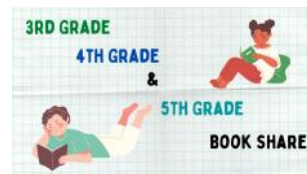

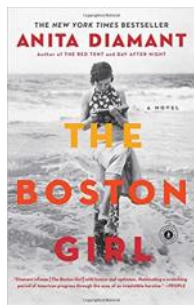
