Toledo Bend Lunker Bass Program – We currently have 12 Lunkers in the 2017-2018 Lunker Bass Program. Lake traffic has decreased significantly with the cooling weather and hunting season getting underway. However, this is a great time to catch a lunker as the bass feed up on shad for the winter.
