Poindexter Street Rezoning

Rezoning request will be rescheduled to July due to site plan changes. New site plan will require SIDA. June Planning Board meeting is canceled. Mike: What are they building on Poindexter? Peggy: Town Homes.

• Avalee Street & Martin Street Subdivision

Project has been submitted to county using current RS20 – Forsyth County Planning board site plan review.

PDR sketch plan. No rezoning request. Site still has an issue with the driveway and must get driveway permit from the town.

• Rocklane / Swain / Celeste / Christian Street Repairs are ongoing. Weather has delayed the start.

Wesley: They have already finished the milling on Christian & Celeste.

Doc: We are 11 months into our new year or ~92% of the way through the year. All in line and on budget with no department over budget. Revenue is coming in at 63%. Expenses at 41 %. Current year property tax at 106%.

§ 143-318.11. CLOSED SESSIONS.

(a) Permitted Purposes. – It is the policy of this State that closed sessions shall be held only when required to permit a public body to act in the public interest as permitted in this section. A public body may hold a closed session and exclude the public only when a closed session is required:

(5) To establish, or to instruct the public body's staff or negotiating agents concerning the position to be taken by or on behalf of the public body in negotiating (i) the price and other material terms of a contract or proposed contract for the acquisition of real property by purchase, option, exchange, or lease; or (ii) the amount of compensation and other material terms of an employment contract or proposed employment contract.
