HOMEMAKING DIVISON RULES

1. All general rules and regulations of the Jim Wells Fair Association will apply.
2. No entry fee will be charged for placing exhibits in the fair; however, all youth entries must be a member of 4-H, FCCLA or an organized club and must sell one (1) fair membership.

AGE GROUPS:

GROUP 1:	Pee-Wee (age as of September 1 st)	Kinder – 2 nd Grade
GROUP 2:	Junior (age as of September 1 st)	3 rd , 4 th , 5 th Grade
GROUP 3:	Intermediate (age as of September 1 st)	6 th , 7 th , 8 th Grade
GROUP 4:	Senior (age as of September 1 st)	9 th , 10 th , 11 th , 12 th Grade
GROUP 5:	Adult	19-59 years
GROUP 6:	Senior Citizens	60 years or over

3. All entries **MUST** be the complete work of the exhibitor and completed within one (1) calendar year of the previous fair. All entries must be undamaged and clean. Unfinished entries will not be accepted.
4. Any entry which has been entered and judged previously in the Jim Wells County Fair, cannot be exhibited or judged again.
5. Participants may enter as many entries in any given division, but only one (1) per class.

6. Entries that do not follow the Homemaking Division Rules will be disqualified. Disqualifications may occur during judging. Acceptance of an entry at check-in is not an acknowledgement that an entry meets all Homemaking Division Rules. The Superintendent of each department has the authority to reject unworthy exhibits or items not packaged according to division rules or reclassify any articles. **Food item requiring refrigeration will not be accepted.**
7. All entries must be pre-registered to be eligible for judging. Registration of entries must have the exact description of each entry. Entry forms will be available from Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Office or Jim Wells County Fair Website. Entries must be turned in by Friday, September 7, 2018 – no later than 4:30 p.m. No late entries will be accepted. **Entry forms must be complete; no entries can be filled out at the Extension Office.**
8. Entries to the Jim Wells County Fair will be taken to the Women's Building on Monday, October 22, 2018 between 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. **No late arrivals will be accepted.** All index cards for entries must be completed and placed with entry before checking in with the department superintendent. Food items must have a copy of the recipe included without name of participant. Pre-registration description must match with item turned in.
9. Judge's orientation will begin at 8:30 a.m. followed by judging of items at 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, October 23, 2018. Only the judges, superintendents, appointed tabulators and extension office staff will be allowed during judging. Superintendents will not be the final tabulators.
10. In each division a class will be established when there are at least two (2) similar pre-registered entries. If there are fewer than two (2) entries, the entry will be placed in the next closest appropriate category or placed in a miscellaneous category.
11. Entries will be judged and given ribbons according to scores received. Ribbons are awarded on the basis of Blue: 90-100; Red: 80-89. Class Champion Ribbons will be awarded in each Class when there are two (2) or more entries. A Blue Ribbon or Class Champion Ribbon is required for a Division Champion Ribbon.
12. Only those entries receiving ribbons will remain on display until Saturday, October 27, 2018. Only a portion of the cakes and pies will be displayed and remaining's must be removed from the Women's Building after judging between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, October 23, 2018. Other items which may be removed on Tuesday are entries that did not receive ribbons, rejected items or disqualifications.

13. A Grand Champion Sweepstake Rosette and Plaque will be awarded to the individual with the greatest number of points in each age group: Pee Wee, Junior, Intermediate, Senior, Adult and Senior Citizen. Points will be tabulated from their judging results, Class Ribbons and Division Champions. Class Ribbons count for 5 points and Division Champion Ribbons count for 10 points. In case of a tie, the individual with the most ribbons will be the winner. All age division runner-ups will receive a Reserve Champion Sweepstake Rosette and Reserve Champion Plaque. The Sweepstakes Awards will be presented at the Parade-of-Champions on Saturday October 27, 2018. The Grand Champion Sweepstakes Award may only be awarded to the same individual two (2) consecutive years in any age group.
14. Participants **cannot** place sale stickers on items. Persons interested in buying items may contact the owner through personnel working at the Women's Building.
15. All entries need to be picked up on Saturday, October 27, 2018 between 8:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. After Saturday, unclaimed items with the exception of food entries will be donated to local charitable organizations. The Homemaking Division will not be responsible for unclaimed items.
16. Any protest must be lodged immediately, with a \$250.00 deposit to the Homemaking Division Superintendent. The \$250.00 will be forfeited if protest is not upheld. Protest Committee will consist of Homemaking Division Superintendent, the entry's Division Superintendent and Fair Board President. Judges decision will be final.

FOOD DEPARTMENT

1. All General Rules of the Jim Wells County Fair apply to this department.
2. Entry forms must be accompanied by the Recipe Form attached. **NOT ENCLOSING THE RECIPE FORM WILL CAUSE A 5 POINT DEDUCTION.** Hand written recipes will not be printed in Cookbook. A copy of your recipe must be attached to bottom of your plate/food item. **Make sure your name is not on this copy.**
3. Canned products such as pickles, canned fruits and vegetables should be shown in standard pint or quart jars. (Example: Kerr, Ball, Etc.) All labels should be 1 ½ inch wide and 3 inches long and placed on the jar opposite the brand name jar with name of recipe and date canned. All canned items will be inspected at check in, if not sealed or spoiled in any manner item will be disqualified.
4. Jelly, Jams, and Preserves should be shown in the standard pint and half pint jars.
5. No prepared mixes may be used as the main ingredient
6. Cakes, Pies and Bread items will be whole when entered. After judging, a portion will be cut and placed on display with ribbon(s). **5 POINTS WILL BE DEDUCTED IF CAKE, PIE OR BREADS ARE PRE-CUT.** The remainder will be returned to the exhibitor between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. on October 23, 2018. If not picked up, the item will be disposed of.
7. Four (4) pieces of candy, cookies, cupcakes, muffins, or rolls will be required for one exhibit. Baked exhibits and candy should be placed on a snack size paper plate and slipped into a storage zip-lock bag. Breads should be placed in large zip-lock bags. Items must be packaged to be accepted along with copy of recipe.
8. Cakes should be put on foil covered cardboard and covered with **CLEAR PLASTIC.** Sheet cakes that are unable to be removed from the pan may be shown in a disposable pan.
9. **ALL BAKED GOOD CONTAINERS MUST BE DISPOSABLE.** Points will be deducted for any items not in a disposable container.
10. Each item entered **WILL NOT** have exhibitors name anywhere on packaging. Points will be deducted if the name is found when packaging is opened by judges and no recipe is attached.
11. Display Cakes will be judged on creativity only. No taste testing.
12. **FOOD NEEDING REFRIGERATION WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AND WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**
13. Use the sheet provided for your recipe – **ready to print.** Make sure all ingredients are typed as well as instructions. Should it have something missing, we will not print it. We will print as received.

2. Attach a 3x5 index card explaining the location season and the effect desired. **5 POINTS WILL BE DEDUCTED IF 3X5 INDEX CARD IS NOT ATTACHED TO PHOTO.**
3. **Size of Photographs:** All photos must be 8x10 in size or 5x7. If you plan to enter same picture from County 4-H Photography Contest in the spring, size must be 8x10 or 5x7.
4. **Mounting of Photographs:** All prints must be permanently mounted solid on photographic mount board (mat board is available at Hobby Lobby, Michael's, or Photo Store). **Photos cannot be framed. If framed, it will not be accepted.** Mount board is not foam of any kind, poster board or sponge board.
5. **Negatives/Picture Disks:** NOT required in any divisions.
6. **Picture Story Division:** Digital entry (one photo) containing three (3) smaller images and minimal text that tells a story.
7. All entries must have been taken on/after the Jim Wells County Fair of last year.
8. Read class divisions carefully as pictures not entered in correct category or following category descriptions will be disqualified.

Photography Class Descriptions:

Animals-Domestic:

Photos focusing on the various animals that have been tamed and made fit for a human environment. To be considered domesticated, the animal must have their behavior, life cycle, or physiology systemically altered as a result of being under human control for many generations.

Examples: Dog, Sheep, Pig, Goat, Cow, Cat, Chicken, Horse, Camel, Goose, Duck, Hamsters.

Animals-Wildlife:

Category focuses on animals not tamed or domesticated and commonly found in the wilderness or the bodies of water throughout the country and world. Photos can be of wildlife in nature, zoos, and/or petting zoos.

Examples: Deer, Snakes, Birds, Insects, Rodents, Elephants, Etc.

Catch-All:

Category for photos that **DO NOT CLEARLY FIT** into one of the other categories.

WHAT IS NOT ALLOWED: Do not submit a photo in this category which can clearly be submitted in another photography category. Catch-All is not intended for the use to eliminate duplicate photos from multiple participants.

Examples: Polaroid image and emulsion transfers, still-life, long exposure zoomed images, and painting with light.

Details & Macro:

Getting in close is the name of the game for this category. We welcome pictures of small details that suggest a larger story. This is also the place for macro photographs (although a macro image of a flower might equally go into the Flora category).

Examples: insects, coins, clocks, stamps, ice crystals.

Dominant Color:

Photos with a dominate color. The dominant element in the image must be a specific color, such as red, yellow, blue, white, black, green, etc. Black & White photos, duotones, are excluded from this category.

Examples: Bowl of lemons, in a yellow bowl, on top of a yellow table covering, with a bright yellow tone sun lighting on it.

Elements of Design:

Images use of graphic elements of design. Photos that showcase line, shape, pattern, form, texture, perspective, etc. Photo can consist of any subject matter. Category is not for graphic illustrations made in commercial programs (i.e. Adobe Illustrator) nor for extreme digital creations.

WHAT IS NOT ALLOWED: Graphic design illustrations made in a program such as Adobe Photoshop or Illustrator. Digital creations DO NOT qualify in this category.

Examples: Perspective, Line, Pattern, Shape

Enhanced:

A single photo that has been technically manipulated to be an abstract, panoramic, stitched or composite images. Other variations are allowed as well.

Example: Photoshop composites and creations, Images greatly manipulated with a variety of filters, Photos with artistic borders, Photos stitched into a panoramic.

Food:

Category is a still life specialization of photography, aimed at producing attractive photographs of food for use in such items of advertisements, packaging, menus and/or cookbooks.

WHAT IS NOT ALLOWED: No photos of alcohol beverages are allowed.

Examples: Thanksgiving dinner, cakes/pies, fruits and place settings, Easter Eggs, sandwiches, ingredients, etc.

Landscape/Nature:

The focus of this category includes landscapes, outdoor scenic, nature images, sunsets, urban landscapes, seascapes, cityscapes, and farms. Images focus on the beauty of the outdoors.

WHAT IS NOT ALLOWED: Photos which primary subject is wildlife or person.

Example: Landscapes/Gardens, Scenic, Outdoors.

Motion/Action:

The capture of movement within a single photo.

WHAT IS NOT ALLOWED: Photos which would clearly fit into another category, such as sports.

Example: Horse running across field/pasture, Ferris Wheel Spinning.

People:

Photos focus from all walks of life, parenting and family, children, babies, models/fashion, sports, and couples.

Example: Babies, Kids , Families, Models/Fashion Sports.

Plant/Flora:

Photos of interesting, unique, and beautiful flowers and flora. Photography can occur outdoors or indoors.

Photo subject should be that of a single flower, plant, bush, tree, etc. Large collections of plant/flora should be considered for entry into the Landscape/ Nature category.

Example: Roses, an upward shot of a tree, a flower bouquet, etc.

Sports:

Photo that captures individual or team sports. Can be either professional or amateur (human) and the focus could be on the sportsperson, the sport environments, the effort expended, or the conflict/rewards. Must reflect a strong message.

Example: Gymnast, Football player or team, Swimming, Rodeo contestant.

Storyboard:

A storyboard is one digital entry (One Photo) that contains three smaller images and minimal text that tells a story. The story should be easily understood by the viewer. The entry is one single file.

Example: Three images depicting the blooming of a rose bud at different stages, with the title of "Beginning of Beauty".

Travel/Place:

This category includes images that express the joys and adventures of travel photography, showcasing place as an important part of the photo. This category can include historic buildings, ruins, islands, any subject you might encounter while traveling, as long as the photo expresses a sense of PLACE.

WHAT IS NOT ALLOWED: Photos in the travel and place category cannot be entered into other categories (landscape & nature), but may be similar, however, photos in this category must depict traveling and experiencing other parts of the world.

Example: Disney World/Land, Roman Ruins, Great Wall of China.
