BY-LAW CHANGE- The board has approved an amendment to the current by-laws that is to be voted upon by written ballot by the members present at the May 17th membership meeting. We would like to remove Article 1, Section 1 B in its entirety. That Section currently reads "an applicant shall have two sponsors who are members of this chapter in good standing for at least two (2) years. a. A member in good standing is one whose dues are paid." The sponsor signatures on the application add no value, and are a confusing relic that have no consequence to either the sponsors or the new member.
