
OCTOBER 2, 2024 ANNULAR ECLIPSE RELIGIOUS AND CIVIL NEW YEAR BOOKENDS

The following Depiction is how and where the October 2, 2024 Annular Solar Eclipse will look like. It will occur in the Constellation of the Sun-Moon-Mercury with the Star of Prophecy, Porrima. What is also notable about this Eclipse is that it is the Bookend to the 3rd and Last Great American Solar Eclipse. It occurred on the Religious New Year of Nisan 1, April 8, 2024. It was based on the Jewish Rabbinical Calendar, as the October 2 is based on the Civil New Year, Tishrei 1. What is also occurring at this Place and Time is how the Planet Venus is in the overall Celestial Configuration. Additionally, the Comet C/2023 A3 Tsuchinshan-ATLAS is crisscrossing the Constellation of Virgo in an 'X' Formation. The Comet amazingly enters and exits at the same Point in the 'Womb' Area approximately 5 Months apart.
