Children spending an extra year at Meadow Flower will be given priority for the 5 day AM program. Please remember in-house families will register before the public and the first public open house is Dec 5th. Siblings can also be registered at this time.

All programs are first come first served. NO TEACHER REQUESTS PLEASE.

The first week in November is American Art week. Art is a very important part of our curriculum; it helps build self-esteem and creativity. Asking questions like "Can you tell me about it?" helps the child share with you what he or she was doing and thinking. It is our intent to simply present the materials, give them some motivation and make sure they can handle all the materials (work with the scissors; squirt the right amount of glue, etc.).

The "greatest works" show the reality of their minds and emotions, not always the reality of the physical appearances. By letting children have a structured setting, big paper and plenty of work space, their creativity can blossom.

We are pleased to offer speech and hearing screenings this month. There is absolutely **NO** obligation to participate; it is strictly a matter of choice. The service is provided for a nominal fee to test speech, hearing or both. Every child who participates will receive a written evaluation the next school day. This is a fun procedure for the children as they get to wear "pilot" headphones and look at pictures. This is a preliminary look at any problems that may show up from this testing. The permission slip and payment (made out to Linda Rembisz) **must** be returned prior to the testing.

Election Day will find some of our classes voting for snack or maybe what toys they will play with for the day. We will also be learning about Pilgrims and Native Americans this month. The children will be asked to think of a Native American name; learn their games and what their homes looked like. Weather permitting we will set up a Native American village. We end our Thanksgiving celebration with a fruit feast. The classes will prepare different fruits and make popcorn for our snack, which we will eat together.

You will also receive the order form for tee shirts. They are due back by Nov 15th and will be ready for the holidays.
