Ordinance No. 2005-55 Amendment

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Marion, in the County of Centre and the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, hereby ordains:

Original Ordinance, No. 2005-55, Section 2 is amended as follows:

Section 2. That the Board shall be composed of three (3) members, to be appointed by the Township Supervisors, with the power to provide and conduct recreation and cultural activities and maintain public recreation areas, facilities, and centers subject to all the responsibilities of the Recreation Enabling Legislation. The Board members shall serve for terms of five years of until their successors are appointed, except that the members first appointed shall be so appointed that the term of one member shall expire annually thereafter. Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments and for the unexpired term. Members shall serve without pay.

The remainder of Ordinance 2005-55 is reaffirmed in its entirety.
