**SCOUTS:**

Before a Scoutmaster Conference for Star, Life and Eagle you must meet with your Patrol Advisor (PA). Prior to that meeting **YOU** must first obtain an Individual History Report (IHR) from TroopMaster and **YOU** must also make sure your Scout Handbook agrees with your IHR. You should pay particular attention to the dates of your Position of Responsibility and your Service Hours requirement.

Bring your IHR, this Advancement Review Questionnaire (ARQ) and your Scout Handbook to the review meeting.

At the meeting with your PA, you will be asked questions from the following list. You will need to answer all questions correctly.

This completed ARQ, your IHR, and your Scout Handbook (each signed by your PA) must then be taken with you to your Scoutmaster Conference. Once you have completed your PA meeting successfully, **YOU** must make an appointment for your Scoutmaster Conference.

For a 1st Class Scoutmaster Conference you need only to bring this ARQ and your Scout Handbook with you to meet with any Patrol Advisor (PA) or FCE Adult Trained Assistant Scoutmaster (ASM). At that meeting the PA or ASM will ask questions from the ARQ and will ensure that your Scout Handbook is current with all appropriate signatures.

**PATROL ADVISORS:**

Each Scout must bring an ARQ, IHR and his Scout Handbook with him to a review meeting with you prior to a Scoutmaster Conference. Please also ensure that the Scout's Handbook agrees with the IHR. If it does not, then determine the correct date with Mr. James Harris (email: [jp.harris@comcast.net](mailto:jp.harris@comcast.net) or Cell: 281-732-7796) and be sure that the Handbook agrees with the IHR. (Note: If there is a discrepancy, the Handbook date should prevail unless it is known to be in error.) If any requirement in the IHR is not complete, discuss it with the Scout and Mr. Harris to ensure completion prior to signing off the ARQ, the IHR and Scout Handbook, which then clears the Scout for his Scoutmaster Conference.

Conduct the review meeting, and if the Scout passes the review, sign the ARQ, IHR and Scout Handbook.

**SCOUTMASTER:**

The Scout must have the IHR, ARQ, and Scout Handbook (each signed off by his PA) prior to holding the Scoutmaster Conference.
