Leo attended Sparling School and was a graduate of Ubly High School, Class of 1955. Leo was a loving husband to Marian Nitz of Harbor Beach since November 29, 1958. They started their life together in Garden City, and after having their first four girls, they moved back home to Ubly and eventually the home they lived in for over fifty-five years. He did many jobs over the years: farming, working at Carmet Company in Bad Axe, Huron Laundry in Harbor Beach, as well as offering his help to whoever needed to put a new roof on their house, etc. He made it a priority to spend lots of quality time with his daughters: he took his girls swimming, fishing, fox hunting, picking blueberries in the marsh, and helped them to raise strawberries, raspberries, and cucumbers.
