1901-1993

Richard J. McKay, 92 of Sebawaing, died Saturday morning, March 13, at Bay Medical Center, Bay City, following a brief illness.

He was born Feb. 9, 1901, in Bay City, the son of George and Catherine (Mayville) McKay. He married Martha Carson on April 10, 1958, in Bay City, and she preceded him in death on Aug. 8, 1966. He then married Lois V. Murphy on Nov. 24, 1978, in Sebawaing, and she preceded him in death on Aug. 3, 1991.

Mr. McKay had been employed as a tool and die maker for Braza & Spaulding Tool and Die of Linwood for 25 years before retiring several years ago.

He was a member of Holy Family Catholic Church in Sebawaing. He had been active in Unionville-Sebawaing Area Senior Citizens. During the 1920s he played on the traveling comedy baseball team of the House of David in Southwestern Michigan for a number of years.

Surviving are one son and two daughters and their spouses: Richard Allen McKay of Battle Creek, Mrs. George (Joan Marilyn) Sebastian of Walled Lake and Mrs. William (Jeannette) White of Birch Run, and several grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Four sisters, Mary Quinn, Nettie Constantino, Rose Olczak and Louise Whitbrodt, all preceded him in death.

The funeral service took place at 11 a.m. Monday, March 15, at Dinkel-Juengel Funeral Home in Sebawaing. Fr. George Serour officiated and burial was in Holy Family Catholic Cemetery, Sebawaing.
