

COMMON ITALIAN WORDS

Here are some more useful words and phrases in Italian which would come in handy if you were travelling in Italy.

Good afternoon = Buon pomeriggio (bwoh-na po-mer-eej-jio)

Good Night = Bounanotte (bwoh-na-noht-teh)

How are you? = Come sta (koh-meh stah)

I am fine/well = Sto bene (stoh beh-neh)

Excuse me = Mi scusi (mee skooh-zee)

Do you Speak English? = Parla Inglese (pahr-lah een-gleh-zeh)

Sorry = Mi Dispiace (mee des-pyah-cheh)

I do not speak Italian very well = Non parlo italiano molto bene (non par-lo ital-ee-an-no mol-to beh-nayh)

How much? = Quanto? (kwanh-toh)

How much does this cost? = Quanto costa questo? (kwan-to kos-ta kwes-to)

I don't understand = Non capisco (non ka-pee-sko)

I would like...= Vorrei (voh-ray)

Where is the train station? = dov'è la stazione (doh-veh lah stah-tsyoh-neh)

Where is the bathroom? = Scusi, dov'è il bango (Skooh-zee doh-veh eel bahn-yoh)

Eat up! = Mangia! (Mahn-ja)

Let's Go! = Andiamo! (on-dee-ah-mo)
