

ORDINANCE #592

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 584 RELATING TO SERVICE CHARGES FOR SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL IN THE CITY OF WESTMORELAND, KANSAS, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WESTMORELAND, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance 584 is amended herein. Ordinance 584 amended Section 2 of Ordinance 559 which amended Section 2 of Ordinance 537 which amended Section 2 of Ordinance 495 which amended Section 2 of Ordinance 576 which amended Section 2 of Ordinance 563 which amended Section 2 of Ordinance 562, which amended Section 2 of Ordinance 559, which amended Section 2 of Ordinance 537, which amended Section 2 of Ordinance 495, which amended section 2 of Ordinance 423, which amended Section 2 of Ordinance 395, which amended Section 6.1. of Ordinance 338 relating to service charges for the collection and disposal of solid waste in the City of Westmoreland, Kansas.

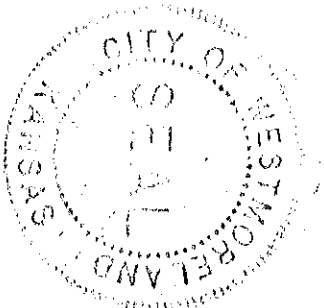
Section 2. The City of Westmoreland, in providing the services of collection and disposal of solid waste, shall collect services charges or fees to defray the cost and maintenance of service and to pay any person contracting with the City for the collection and disposal of solid waste. Such service charges or fees shall be as follows:

- a. Solid Waste Collection Fee For Persons or Residences Engaged in Contractor's Program (Residential Collection Services): The following rates shall apply for those residences engaged in the Contractor's program: (i) For a residence, the rate for once weekly waste collection service shall be the sum of \$21.00 per month per dwelling unit.


Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect November 1, 2022 and shall be in full force after its passage and publication in the official City newspaper.
