A Vintage Flea is a semi-annual sale with vendors carrying anything from antique and mid-century furniture to handmade crafts, repurposed furniture, and home decor. A limited amount of new products (purchased for resale) may be allowed to augment booths but the primary mission of A Vintage Flea is to gather together vendors carrying authentic antiques, vintage, repurposed, and handcrafted items.

Vendors may rent either a 12'x12' or 12'x24' space inside the covered, retail greenhouse at Margie's Farm & Garden. Craft vendors, or anyone with a smaller amount of product, may instead rent an area where all items for that space **MUST** be offered on an 8' maximum table. Vendors can bring their own tables or an 8' folding table can be rented from the venue for \$10. Vendors in 12x12 or larger spaces are invited to bring walls and/or canopies to use in the setup of their space. However, *canopy tops are not advised for the November market* as the Friday Night hours are after dark and the greenhouse lighting is from above. Vendors must also be aware that the greenhouse is, for the most part, an unheated space and delivers a wide range of moderate temperatures throughout the event. Vendors are advised to dress accordingly as the Friday Night event can be cool and the greenhouse front door will remain open during sale hours to facilitate attendees. **Once application is approved, rental fees will be due by October 1st, 2020.** Fees will not be returned if the vendor fails to show or cancels within 30 days of show date.

Vendor set-up will be Thursday, Nov. 19th, 10am to 6pm, as well as, Friday, Nov. 20th, 9am to 4pm.

Vendors are prohibited from selling items prior to the opening of the Friday Night Early Buy event.

Tear down will be Saturday, Nov. 21st, 4pm to 7pm and Sunday, Nov. 22nd, 10am to noon. **Packing booths before 4pm on Saturday is strictly forbidden and may result in vendor elimination from future sales.** All vendors must be at the sale prior to opening and someone must always be available during the sale.

Vendor parking will be off-site on sale days and accessible by shuttle before and after the market hours only. Be advised that facilities will be portable toilets brought in specifically for the event. Vendors will leave their space in as-found condition and will remove any trash with them. Vendors will act as their own cashier. There is WIFI available for credit transactions and ATMs for cash withdrawals.

The sale site is under monitored surveillance. All caution will be made in an effort to keep the site secure. However, vendors agree that A Vintage Flea, the event manager, nor the venue should be held responsible or financially liable for any personal injury, damaged or stolen merchandise or personal property, or losses of any kind. The vendors assume all liability for loss or damage to the venue property and waive any claim against above mentioned parties. Vendors are encouraged to seek personal liability insurance and, if so, name Margie's Farm & Garden and Red Dog Events LLC as additional insureds.

Management has the right to revoke spaces and cancel reservations. Items sold must be in compliance with local laws and ordinances. Management takes no responsibility for item validity or the vendors' legal right to sell. Vendors shall not operate in a discourteous unprofessional manner, sell prohibited items including firearms, pornographic material, food, drinks, items violating trademark regulations, or any other item found objectionable by management. No mass produced or commercial products as sold by representative, ie: Scentsy, Pampered Chef, etc. No used clothing unless it has been altered and repurposed by the vendor. Please be respectful of our venue, Margie, and the products she sells in her business, ie: no plants, planted containers, or nursery stock *unless approved by Kathy beforehand.*

Kathy Jacoby owns and manages the sale including all communication with vendors, set up and tear down on the days of the sale, and collecting all payments. The sale will be advertised in various printed and digital forms such as: local newspapers, social media, flea market portals, retail posters, postcards, street signage, tv, etc. Vendors are encouraged to help with promotion by distributing available marketing material, i.e. postcards, flyers, posters, etc. A pdf flyer is available for mailing list distribution.

Margie's Farm & Garden will provide a clean and ample space with parking and portable restroom facilities. Heavy promotion is done in her daily operations. Electricity can be provided to vendors for a \$10 fee.
