CONDITIONS FOR BIDDING:

1. The Village of Beach City will receive sealed bids at the Village Hall at 105 East Main Street Beach City OH 44608 until 11:00 a.m. on Friday, November 29, 2019.
2. The Bidder shall follow specification sheets as provided for items bid, or list exceptions. Bids shall include delivery to Village of Beach City Fire Department, 102 West Main Street Beach City OH 44608, all bids shall be net delivered price (F.O.B. Village of Beach City, Stark County, Ohio) and exempt from excise and sales tax. Bidders are to furnish exemption certificates.
3. Each proposal shall be made on the attached bid form and must include the signature of the owner or authorized officer/s of the organization submitting said bid and complete mailing address of said organization. Any exceptions to these specifications must be noted and any supplementary or supportive materials may be attached. Equal as well as substitute bids will be considered.
4. Bids are to be submitted in a sealed opaque envelope, clearly marked "BEACH CITY FIRE DEPARTMENT BID – ATTN: CLERK-TREASURER"
5. The bidder shall supply warranty information.
6. Non-collusion form must be completed and notarized.
7. The Village reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
8. These specifications must be returned with the bid proposal. Any and all exceptions to the specifications outlined herein must be noted on this bid specification and thoroughly explained in the bid proposal. It will be the responsibility of the Fire Department to determine if a substitution to the specification is considered "equal to". The bidder must provide with any exceptions, detailed specifications so that the Fire Department can make the necessary comparisons to make a proper decision. Failure to do so may result in rejection of your bid for noncompliance. Exceptions must be noted on the spec sheet.

Bids will be accepted until 11:00 a.m. Friday, November 29, 2019

The Fire Department reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any and all technicalities and to award the contract to the best bidder.
