BACKGROUND

Every minute 20 people leave everything behind to escape war, persecution or terror.

REFUGEES

A refugee is someone who fled his/her home and country owing to "a well-founded fear of persecution because of his/her race, religion, nationality, membership in a particular social group, or political opinion", according to the United Nations Refugee Convention. Many refugees are in exile to escape the effects of natural or human-made disasters.

REBUILDING LIVES IN PEACE AND DIGNITY

UNHCR provides legal protection for refugees and seeks long-lasting solutions to their problems, by helping them either return voluntarily to their homes or settle in other countries. Its objective is to help refugees and other forcibly displaced persons rebuild their lives in peace and dignity. The agency aims to uphold the rights of all displaced people, including women, children, older persons and people living with disabilities. Its seeks to reunite them with their families, protect them from sexual exploitation, abuse, violence and military recruitment, and offers education and training, health services, etc.

ACTIONS

There is an even greater need **to promote tolerance and respect for people forced to flee.** Today almost 500 universities, businesses, foundations, faith-based organizations, youth groups, and NGOs are working together to play a decisive and visible role in providing hope and help to refugees and asylum seekers. We have a unique and historic opportunity to create a global movement. Our voices are louder and actions stronger when we work together. #WithRefugees Coalition
