1. Valet Parking

All parking at the hotel is valet (no self-parking). The West Road valet parking will be open from 5 am to 6 pm. Please review the driving instructions and map posted on this website. The hotel is extending a special \$28 rate for valet parking at the hotel for the day (Saturday only.) The rate is not applicable to overnight stays and is not applicable to other parking venues near the hotel. Please pre-pay parking at the parking desk located in the Diamond Ballroom Foyer.

2. E-sign in and Scholarship Checks

OCS takes place in the Diamond Ballroom (see Diamond Ballroom layout posted on this website.) E-sign in starts at 5 am as you enter the Diamond Ballroom Foyer at the top of the escalator. Don't forget to pick up your badge and conference bag after you sign in. You must sign in before 9 AM, attend the entire OCS program and be present at the end of the day to collect your scholarship check. Only non-industry nurses who have attended the full day are eligible for scholarships. Scholarship Checks will be dispersed in the Learning Resource Center (LRC) starting at 5 PM.

3. Learning Resource Center (LRC)/ Passport

5. Internet

6. Meals
