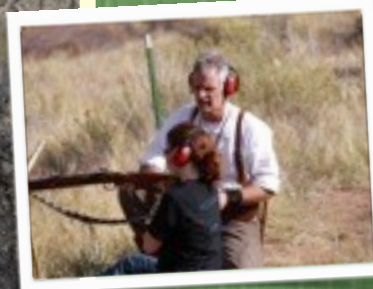


The Buckhorn Skinners Newsletter
