- 1. This plaque shall become the permanent property of the Unit winning it for three (3) consecutive years if they desire. The permanent winner will place another plaque in the Department for competition with the rules and name to remain the same.
- 2. Judging of Unit reports for the awarding of the plaque shall be made by a committee of three (3)
 Auxiliary members appointed by the Department Chairman.
- 3. In order to qualify for this plaque, the Unit must report the fund raising activity, or activities they help to benefit the program. This narrative report must be typed, not to exceed 1,000 words and received by May 1st annually. The narrative should include how the Unit involved the members of the community in this program. A copy of the report must be attached to the narrative.
- 4. The purpose of this award is to stimulate and help promote this very important program for our Veterans.
