Avoid Contact with Power Infrastructure

Please consider these safety tips when working around above and below ground power infrastructure.

Review the height of your equipment.

If equipment is new, confirm the height, update your GPS with any changes and carefully consider your route to ensure you can cross safely under power lines. Exercise caution at all times but particularly if equipment is higher than 4.1 meters (13.5 feet).

Plan before moving tall equipment.

Map your route and locate and remember where any overhead power lines are located along that route. If you don't know whether it's safe to cross under or work near a power line, call ATCO for help: 1-855-277-1670.

Stay 7 meters away from power lines.

Keep this in mind when operating equipment like grain augers and air seeders, or when lifting truck boxes or back hoes.

Stack and store wisely.

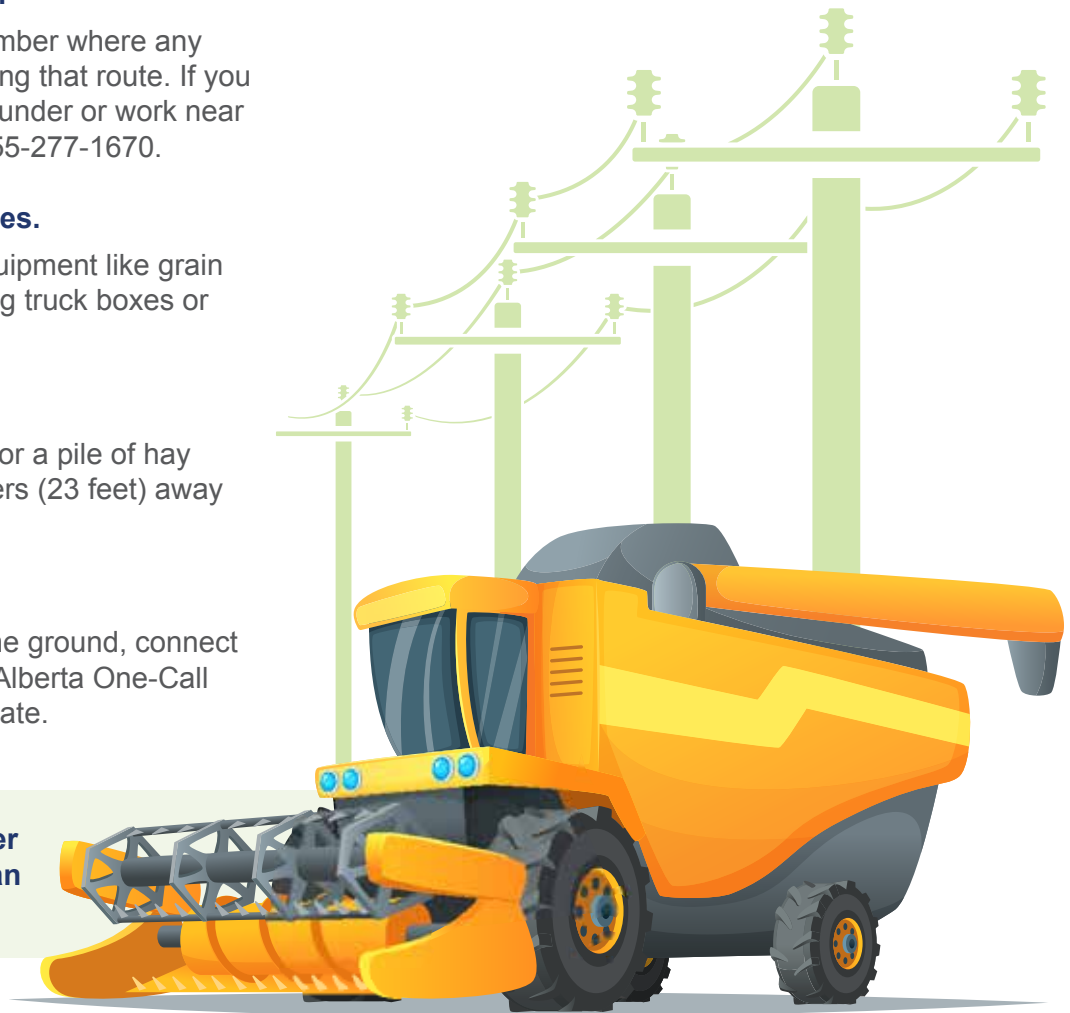
Whether you're storing grain in a bin or a pile of hay bales, stack and store at least 7 meters (23 feet) away from power lines.

Dial or Click before you dig.

Before digging or driving posts into the ground, connect with Utility Safety Partners (formerly Alberta One-Call Corp.) to request an underground locate.

Utility Safety Partners is a not-for-profit organization and there is no charge to you for this service. It only takes a few minutes to submit a locate request—and the consequences of not knowing where those utilities are could last a lifetime. Call 1-800-242-3447 or on-line at utilityafety.ca/where's-the-line/submit-a-locate-request. You will receive a confirmation indicating when the locate will be completed.

REMEMBER – Utilities are closer to the surface of the ground than you think.



Regulated Rate Option (RRO)

The RRO rate may increase or decrease from month to month as it is priced on the open market and subject to many factors relating to supply and demand. If you do not have a contract with an electricity retailer, then you receive the default RRO rate.

For February 2023, the RRO is priced at \$0.13500 per kWh, which is reflected on your enclosed bill. For March 2023, the Battle River Power Coop monthly RRO billing rate for FENN REA members is \$0.13500. The RRO rate is also listed on www.fennrea.com.
