The following Board members met and reviewed the irrigation water request list as prepared by Dave and Beulah: Ken McDougald Darwin Gilger, D.L. Taylor, Jim Wiseman and Curt Young.

ATTENDANCE

Fifty-six property owners have responded to a questionnaire sent out to San Juan and Grand County residents. They have requested 4,073.9 acre feet of water to irrigate 1,008.61 acres of land.

QUESTIONNAIRE

Board members felt that the irrigation line generally should follow existing county road right-of-ways.

IRRIGATION
LINE

Several questions were asked and suggestions were made, such as:

How much water can the District store in the reservoir from Pack Creek? The Board might consider charging the Pack Creek water users a storage fee and possible delivery fee, and obtain excess water not normally used by the farmers for storage in the reservoir. It was suggested that Tom Clyde might meet with the Board to discuss formulating an agreement with Pack Creek water users: Ray Holyoak, Arnel Holyoak, Don Holyoak, Neal Dalton and Sam Sommerville.

PACK CREEK
WATER

First obligation was to serve residents of Grand County, based on a cost involved to serve them. It was suggested that perhaps the District should consider selling water for five years at a time.

GRAND & SAN
JUAN COUNTY

How long can we commit ourselves to sell water to the farmers?

Can anyone obtain control of a water right when we sell various farmers irrigation water?


Are there any legal restrictions on selling water to residents of San Juan County?

The Board reviewed the piping system for a million gallon culinary water storage tank and water trunk lines. The question was raised as to whether it would be practical to pipe the water from the million gallon storage tank directly into the City's 16" water main which comes from the springs area by the golf course. Bretzke stated that the estimated cost for a million gallon storage tank was \$160,000.


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The question was raised concerning utilizing the existing irrigation lines at the golf course to tie into a possible extension of the irrigation pipe line to the golf course.
