

# **Our SPRING BREAK CAMP is just around the corner**

## **Here's what you need to know...**

We are offering two SPRING CAMPS. Information on these camps can be found below. ### **HOW WILL THESE CAMPS WORK?**

**We have two separate weeks of camps:**

**The first SPRING BREAK CAMP runs March 27, 28, 29, 30, 31. These are the days that the VISTA and SAN MARCOS districts are out of school .**

**The second SPRING BREAK CAMP runs April 10, 11, 12, 13, 14. These are the days the OCEANSIDE and CARLSBAD districts are out.**

You can register for one, two, three or more days. If you register your child for the week, you will receive a discount on your registration

### **WHAT HAPPENS IN THE CAMPS FROM DAY TO DAY?**

Each day we will celebrate the theme of the camp in short shows, skits, crafts, and all other activities. So if you are only registering for a couple of days, each day is it's own mini-camp. All the camps will run from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. daily. We will be offering early drop off at 8:00 a.m. for an additional \$5.00 a day. We will also offer late pick up at 6:00 p.m. for an additional \$5.00 a day.

### **CAMP ENROLLEMENT FEES:**

To begin with, campers must be between the ages of 7 and 14 years. Single day camps are \$40.00. Enroll in all 5 days and the cost is \$175.00. That's a savings of \$25.00. Each day we must have no less than 15 kids registered, per day. If enrollment is below 15 kids, the camp will be canceled 72 hours prior to the camp. Maximum enrollment is 40 kids per day.

## **WHAT IS PROVIDED TO THE CAMPERS?**

We will provide all the craft supplies; any costumes that the kids will use and a DVD download of the show or skit the campers will be performing at the end of the day.  
\*NOTE: NOT ALL OF THE CAMPS WILL BE FILMING SKITS. We also provide a morning and afternoon snack and during lunch the kids can purchase items from our concessions stand for \$1.50 a piece. **As always, lunch must be provided by the parent.** Camps will be taught by Broadway Theater owners, Randall Hickman, Douglas Davis and several of their summer camp directors. This is the first year we have offered a Spring Break Camp! Our November and January camps were a blast..so we are hoping these camps will be the same.
