This Month's Reminder

LAWNCARE

Fall cleanups are now in full swing as crews battle Mother Nature in a race to beat the snow. Fall cleanups consist of leaf & debris removal and mowing (as needed). Please note, if you are a routine mowing customer that is not scheduled for a fall cleanup and would like a final mow please contact our office asap.



SOFTSCAPES

Our landscape crews are finished with install projects for the season and are now focused on fall pruning. Fall pruning consist of cutting back perennial flowers and some grasses to keep them looking tidy and control diseases. Corrective pruning, shaping, and removing lower/larger tree limbs can also be done during fall pruning.





Fall's morning dew delivers moisture to help turf absorb the fertilizer. The grass has a chance to build stamina before a chilly winter. Supporting root growth in fall leads to a healthier, greener lawn in spring. *What are the benefits of deep root feeding trees and shrubs?* Deep root feeding stimulates root growth and aids flowering, fruit development, and healthy foliage. Also, creates an increased resistance to disease and pest infestations and improves soil conditions and neutralizes nutrient deficiencies.
