Paso Robles

GRAPE VARIETIES

69% Petite Sirah, 31% Petit Verdot

ALCOHOL

15.0%

VINIFICATION

Produced from west side estate fruit. Hand picked into half ton bins. Cold soaked at 40 degrees for seven days. Varietals co-fermented together. Extended skin contact for three to five weeks. Pumped over five to six times per day. Pressed and pumped to barrels. Aged 20 months in a combination of French and American oak.

TASTING

This is a big inky/purple wine made from a blend of Petite Sirah and Petit Verdot. Amazing body and a great nose make way for the rich, ripe flavors of blackberries, plums and currants touched with mocha, vanilla and spice. Splendid lingering long finish.
