Many people qualify for Extra Help in paying for their prescription drug coverage. **If you qualify, Medicare may pay all or part of your prescription drug costs, monthly Part D premiums and/or your annual deductible.**

You may qualify for Extra Help if:

Medicare Savings Program

If you qualify, your state may pay all or part of your:

- Monthly Medicare Part B premiums
- Coinsurance, deductible and copays

Utility assistance programs

- Electricity
- Heating
- Telephone

Special enrollment period

In addition to financial assistance, you may also be eligible for a special enrollment period. This allows you to change your health plan any time during the year, so you can switch to a plan that may better meet your health care needs.
