

# SHERMAN DAY

## 1906 - 1993

Sherman E. Day, 86 of Colfax Township, passed away Sunday, March 14 at Four Seasons Health Care in Bad Axe after a long illness.

He was born Dec. 23, 1906 in Huron Township near Port Austin, son of the late George and Margaret (McDonald) Day. He married Eva Foster on April 20, 1935 in Bad Axe.

Mr. Day was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Bad Axe, where he served as an usher and was a member of the Robert's Class.

He attended the Shepherd School and farmed in Colfax for the past 50 years, and was a member of the Colfax Grange.
