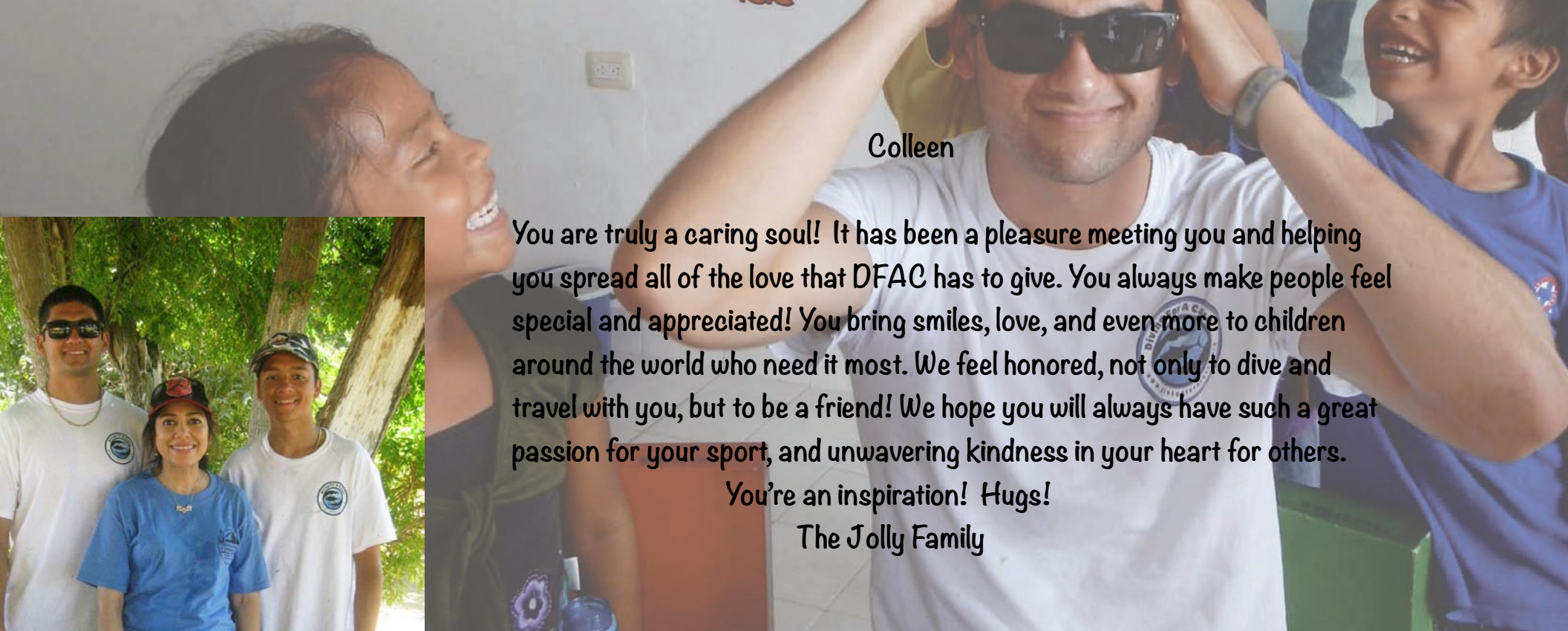

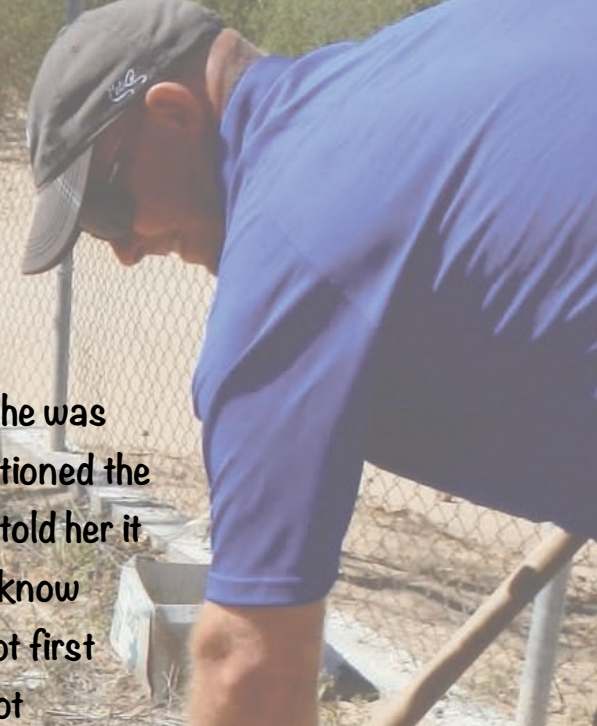

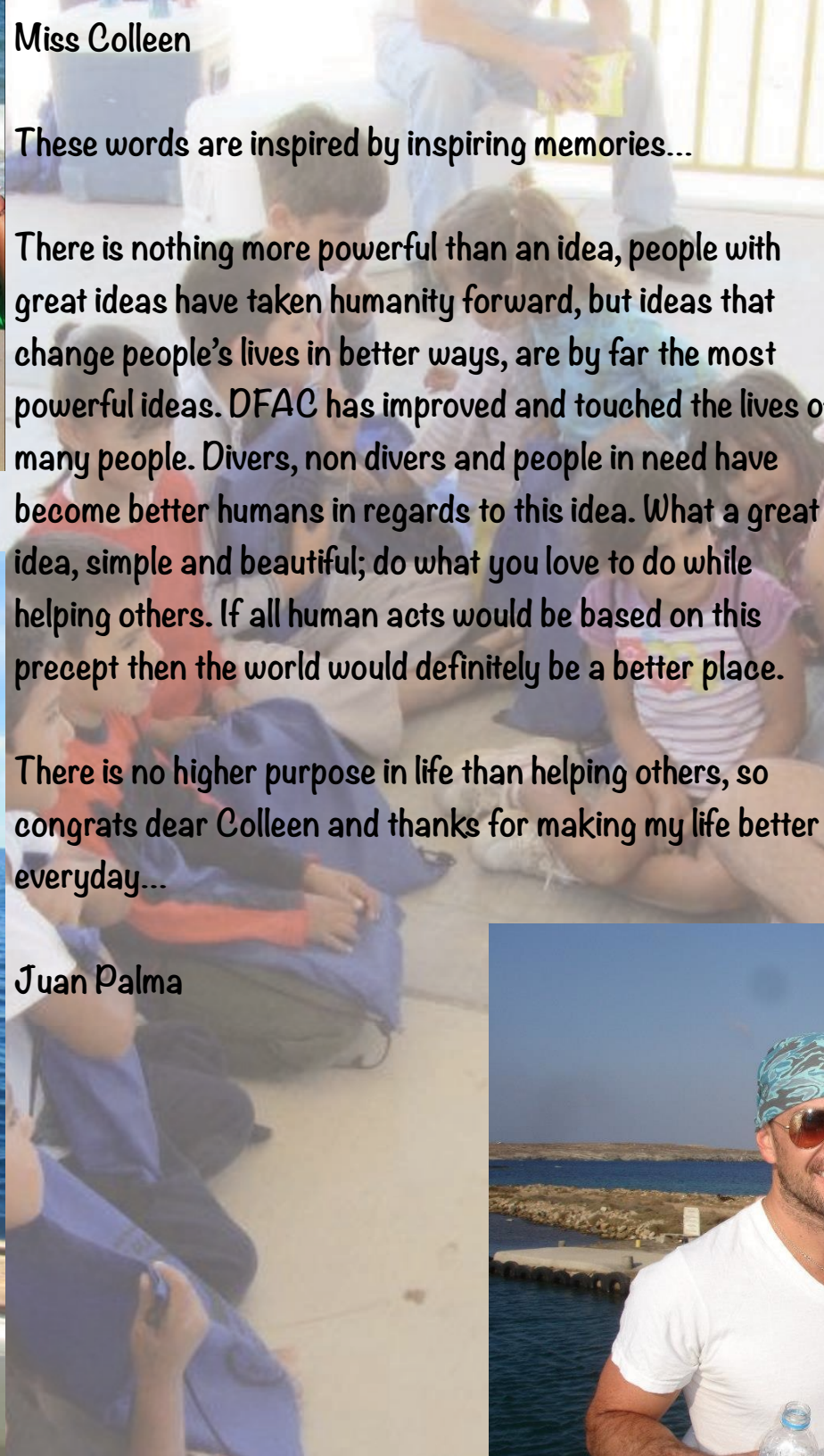
Miss Colleen

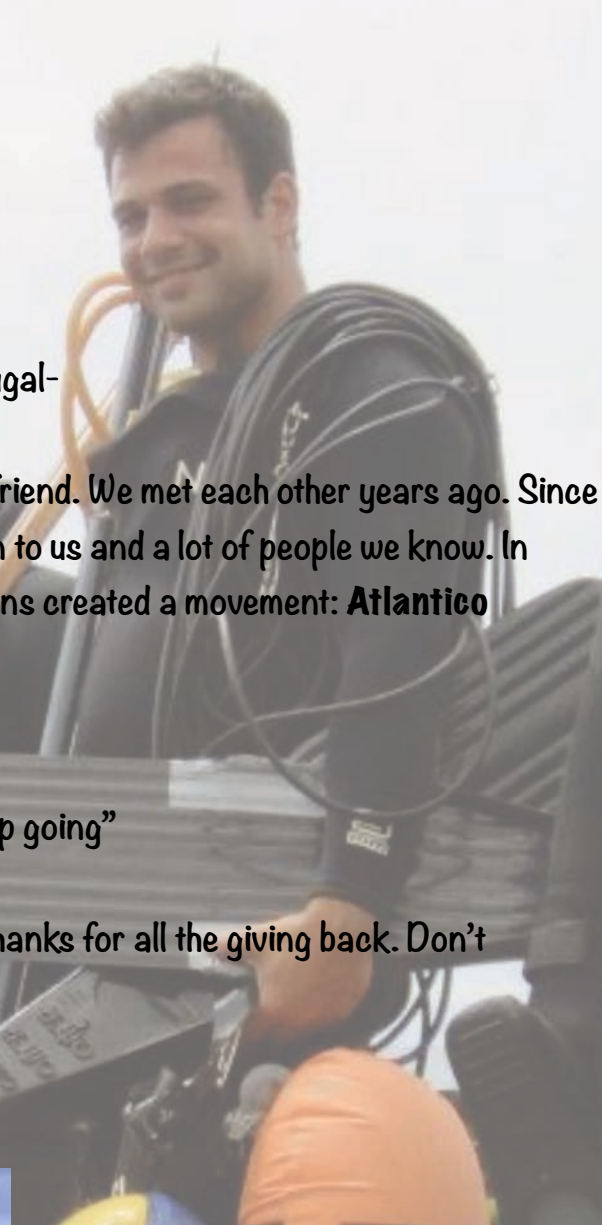




Hi Colleen

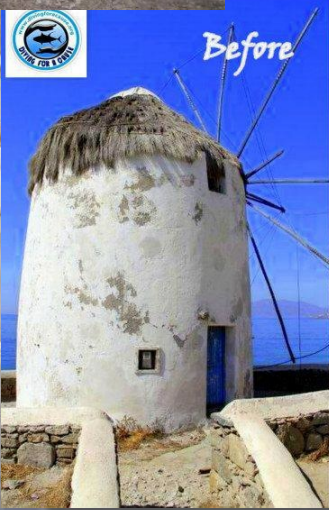

“The success of DFAC stems from Colleen’s compassion and empathy, which has crossed-over from her nursing career. I have been witness to this spirit since 2010 when my husband Atil & I read about DFAC’s philanthropic trips via social media. As the parents of a child with the rare disease Cystic Fibrosis, we held fundraisers annually and were planning a spearfishing event in the Outer Banks of North Carolina. Atil reached out to Colleen and in November 2010 we had our first meeting in Virginia Beach. We partnered with DFAC to raise money through spearfishing, and Colleen used the leveraging force of the internet to promote the event. Since 2011, DFAC has held events in North Carolina, the Bahamas, and Texas to raise money to fund scientific research to find a cure for Cystic Fibrosis. DFAC has made freedivers/spearfishers ambassadors of change, bringing much needed awareness to Cystic Fibrosis. On the other hand of the spectrum are the people with Cystic Fibrosis who are introduced to freediving/spearfishing with its benefit of salt water, sea air, and exercise.
