Registered Tournament - This Sectional is a registered tournament, and all guidelines for registered tournaments will be followed. Sectionals are operated by match staff composed of local officials. All local challenges and protests are to be resolved on the match site according to procedures outlined in Section 16 of the appropriate NRA Rulebook. Results from this Sectional will be combined with results from other locations to determine National team and individual rankings.

Individual Categories -

1. **Junior:** Born 2000, 2001, 2002
2. **Intermediate Junior:** Born 2003, 2004, 2005
3. **Sub-Junior:** Born 2006 or later
4. **Military Scholastic:** Active member of a high school JROTC unit or enrolled in a military high school. NRA Rule 2.9.1.

Teams - No team only entries allowed, Categories: Junior, Intermediate Junior, Sub-Junior, Scholastic, Military Scholastic

Scoring - Orion Scoring System

Note: 4H Air Rifles will be entered in the Sporter Division

AIR RIFLE 3-POSITION (SPORTER and PRECISION Divisions)

MATCH 1: Individual Match - 20 shots prone.

MATCH 2: Individual Match - 20 shots standing.

MATCH 3: Individual Match - 20 shots kneeling.

Matches must be fired in the order listed above.

MATCH 4: Sectional Individual 3-P Air Rifle Championship

(An aggregate of Matches 1, 2, and 3)

MATCH 5: Sectional Team Sporter and Precision 3- P Air Rifle Championship

(Based on Matches 1, 2, and 3)

MATCH 6: National Individual Indoor Sporter and Precision 3-P Air Rifle Championship

(Based on Matches 1, 2, and 3)

MATCH 7: National Team Indoor Sporter and Precision Air Rifle Championship

(Based on Matches 1, 2, and 3)

INDIVIDUAL MATCHES

Rules: Current **NRA** Air Rifle Position Rules will govern.

Rifle: NRA Rules 3.1 and 3.2

Positions: NRA Rules 5.6, 5.10 and 5.12

Sights: NRA Rule 3.7.1

Distance: 10 meters

Sighting Shots: NRA Rule 9.2

Time Limits: Will follow CMP rules.

Target: NRA Rule 4

Tie Scores: Ties will be broken using NRA Rule 15.

TEAM MATCH

Team Matches: NRA Rules 2.3 and 2.11(a) open to teams consisting of four (4) firing members and a Team Captain (who must be designated) who may also be a firing member of the team. The Team must represent a single NRA Affiliated Club. The Team Coach may be an adult. A competitor may not fire on more than one team in any one Sectional or Sectional type in a given year. A team is not required to fire on the same relay, but must fire at the same sectional and location.

Team Entries: The team match is *not* a fired match (Paper Match). Team entry cards must have the names of all team members and alternate listed, and be submitted to the entry office **before** any member of the team fires. An alternate may be named and substituted for any named team member, as long as it is before either person has fired. (Rule 12.4)

Course of Fire: An aggregate of scores fired by team members in the individual match. Team members must be designated before firing the individual match. "Team Only" entries will *not* be allowed.

Tied Team Scores: Will be broken using Rule 15.7

Coaching: Not allowed. (Rule 9.10).

Minimum Qualifying Team Score for the shoulder to shoulder National Open Air Rifle Championship (May 3-5 Bloomington IL) is **2000 Sporter and 2280 Precision.**

Awards

Sectional Awards - Awards furnished by NRA are as shown in this program. The overall high scoring individual(s) and team will be awarded the Sectional Championship Awards regardless of any categories entered.

National Bulletin - The National Junior Indoor Championship Bulletin will list all individual competitors and teams ranked according to score within a category. Final results will be posted on the Competitions website: <http://competitions.nra.org/championship-results/nra-national-indoor-rifle-pistolchampionships-results.aspx> An award is presented to competitors who placed in the top 10% in either 3-Position Precision Air Rifle or 3-Position Sporter Air Rifle (not to exceed 100).

Winning Team: (4) Gold Medals (5 in BB Gun), minimum of 2 teams.

INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONSHIPS:

To the high scoring competitor, a Gold NRA Medallion and:
3-Position Air Rifle, Precision: NRA Trophy Plaque
3-Position Air Rifle, Sporter: NRA Trophy Plaque
Second Place, All Events: Silver Medallion
Third Place, All Events: Bronze Medallion

The above awards will be given to the high scoring eligible competitors regardless of category.

Championship Category Awards:

The junior categories are: Military Scholastic; Junior, Intermediate Junior, or Sub-Junior. Category awards will be given to the high scoring competitors who have not received one of the awards listed above.

First Place with a minimum of 8 competitors in the category
Second Place with a minimum of 16 competitors in the category
Third Place with a minimum of 24 competitors in the category
Fourth Place with a minimum of 32 competitors in the category
Fifth Place with a minimum of 40 competitors in the category
An additional award will be given for each additional 25 competitors in a category.

TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS

To the Highest Scoring Team in the country, a Championship Banner and:
3-Position Air Rifle, Precision: 5 NRA Award Plaques
3-Position Air Rifle, Sporter: 5 NRA Award Plaques

SPECIAL TEAM AWARDS:

Team Category Awards: All team category awards will be medals, awards will be based on participation—

5 Teams=1st in category;
10 Teams=2nd in category;
15 Teams=3rd in category;
20 Teams=4th in category awards.

One additional award will be given for each additional 20 teams in a category. Only one category award will be given per team.
