

ORDINANCE 767

To prohibit persons from obstructing sidewalks in front of places of business.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Garnett, Kansas.

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to place or to allow to be placed upon any sidewalk, any box, barrel, goods or wares of any description, or in any manner obstruct any sidewalk in front of the lot where such wares or articles of any kind are found or offered for sale.

Section 2. Whoever shall violate any of the provisions of Section 1 of this ordinance shall, ~~be liable to a fine~~ upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than \$1.00 or more than \$25.00.

Section 3. That Section Two (2) of Ordinance number Twenty-two (22) be and is hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall be and is in full force and effect from and after ten days after its passage and approval and publication in the official paper of said city.
