Richwood Park Rules and Regulations

No tampering with, destroying, vandalizing, defacing or otherwise park structures, facilities and trees.

No water skiing, wading, or playing in the Richwood Lake.

Swimming at beach area only, no life guard on duty, swim at own risk.

Dogs and all other pets must be kept on a leash at all times. (pet waste must be cleaned up and disposed of properly)

Speed limit shall be limited to 5mph within the park.

Driving or parking shall be in designated or parking areas only

No littering – please dispose of all litter in available trash cans. (\$500.00 fine for littering O.R.C 37.67.32)

No weapons or explosive devices of any kind permitted

No ATV's, trail bikes, go carts, wave runners or any other unauthorized motor vehicles permitted.

No bicycles, skate boards, rollerblades, or skates are permitted on the tennis or basketball courts.

No alcoholic beverages permitted at any time.

No open fires permitted, except the fireplace at the shelter house and park grills. (Authorized organizations exempt)

No residential / business trash shall be brought into or disposed of in any park containers.

No State fishing license required.

All Ohio watercraft regulations under section 1547 of the Ohio Revised Code shall be in force. Any boat left at the Richwood Lake shall be marked with the owner's name, address, and telephone number and must be secured by lock and chain.

Only electric boat motors permitted.

No ice fishing, skating, snowmobiles or any other winter activities on the frozen surface of the Richwood Lake. Only authorized exceptions.

Night fishing permitted after regular closing hours of the park.

Shelter houses can be reserved and renter. Call 740-943-3315 from 8:30-4:00 Monday – Friday. Closed from 12:00-1:00 for lunch daily.
