TOWN OF MARYSVILLE, MN EMERGENCY DECLARATION NO. 2025-02 SLOW-NO-WAKE RESTRICTION — DEER LAKE

WHEREAS, as of June 30th, 205, the water level of **Deer Lake** (DNR Public Water I.D. 86010700) has exceeded an elevation of **913.00 feet**, creating shoreline erosion hazards and threats to public safety and property; and

WHEREAS, immediate action is necessary to protect life, property, and the environment pending Town Board consideration of a longer-term measure should high-water conditions persist;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Minnesota Rules 6110.300 - 6110-3800 the undersigned hereby declare:

- 1. Slow-No-Wake Zone Established. A slow-no-wake restriction of five (5) miles per hour is imposed on all motorized watercraft operating within six hundred (600) feet of any shoreline on Deer Lake.
- 2. **Effective Date and Duration**. This declaration is effective upon signing and posting on June 30, 2025, and shall remain in effect until Deer Lake reaches an elevation of 912.50 feet; or for a maximum of thirty (30) days unless terminated earlier or extended by formal action by the Marysville Town Board and approval of the Commissioner of the Minnesota Department of Natural Resources (DNR).
- 3. Public Notice. The Town Clerk/Treasurer is directed to:
 - 1. Post conspicuous notices of this restriction at all public water-access sites and on the Town's official website and social media channels;
 - 2. Notify the Wright County Sheriff's Office and the MN DNR as soon as practicable; and
 - 3. Provide a copy of this declaration to local media outlets and affected lake-association representatives.
- 4. Enforcement. The Wright County Sheriff's Office is responsible for the enforcement of the declaration.
- 5. **Exemptions**. Law enforcement and public safety personnel are exempt from the requirements of this declaration.
